- **Note-1:** He/she has completed age of 17 years at the time of admission or will complete that age on or before 31 December of the year of his/her admission. The candidates must have born on or before 31.12.2008 to the first year of admission in the undergraduate course.
- Note-2: The candidates who have applied under Sports category will have to submit printed / hard copy of online submitted application form personally (by hand) in the University within stipulated period alongwith self-attested photocopies of 10+1 & 10+2 DMC's, Sports Gradation Certificate issued by the Director, Sports, Punjab and other supporting certificates/documents.

Credit and admission shall be made on the basis of inter-se-merit of the candidates determined on the basis of gradation (Category A/B/C) as per the Sports Policy notified by Department of Sports & Youth Services, Government of Punjab.

- **Note-3:** Candidate shall mandatory upload the Detailed Marks Card (DMC) of 10+2 examination on University website i.e. <u>www.bfuhs.ac.in</u>
- **Note-4:** Provisional Merit will be displayed on 25th **June, 2025**. If any candidate found any discrepancy in his/her merit he/she shall mail us relevant documents at email id i.e. <u>ug2021bfuhs@gmail.com</u> for rectification till 26th **June, 2025 (upto 02:00 pm),** failing which he/she is not liable to claim his/her right to earlier seat, if cancelled due to discrepancy found at the time of checking eligibility/document verification by the Principal of allotted college. Thereafter, his/her candidature will be considered in 2nd round of counseling as per correction in merit.
- **Note-5:** The allotment in the counseling will be provisional and subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned College at the time of joining/reporting. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the allocated candidate as per Prospectus/rules before joining/admission.
- **Note-6:** Candidates who have passed 10+1 and 10+2 from State other than Punjab shall be considered during 2nd Round of Counseling.

BRIEF HISTORY:

The University was established at Faridkot under an Act of Punjab State Legislature (Punjab Act No. 18 of 1998) in the name of great Sufi Saint Sheikh Farid Ganj-E-Shakar, (1173 1265 A.D.) in 1998 for purposes of affiliating, teaching and ensuring proper and systematic instruction, training and research in Modern Systems of Medicine and Indian Systems of Medicine. It is not only affiliating and examining body but also a teaching and research centre in health sciences. It is expected to play a vital role in improving the standards of medical and health education in the state and in conducting relevant research in all aspects of health sciences, basic as well as applied, which ultimately will ameliorate the health standards of the people of Punjab. II is believed that the university will be a trend setter in developing appropriate modes and models of health care to ensure quality health care to the people.

The University has been recognized by MCI vide letter no. V/11015/3/2000-ME (UG) dated 9th June, 2000. The UGC has also included the University in the list of recognized universities maintained by the University Grants Commission, under section 2(1) of the UGC Act. 1956 vide letter no. F.9-3/97 (CPP-I) dated 4 July. 2002. The Regional Director. World Health Organization, Regional Office for South-East Asia, World Health House, New Delhi has also forwarded the name of the University for inclusion in the World Directory of Medical Schools vide letter No. M12/6212 dated 6 May 2002. The University is also included in the list of Commonwealth Universities and their yearbook 2001 at page No. 692 (Vol. I).

Established with a mission to create an intellectual, academic and physical environment conducive to free flow of ideas and exchange of information between various faculties of the university, between this university and other universities of health sciences in the country and abroad, thereby opening a window to the world for the health professionals, health planners, health managers, biomedical and social scientists and educationalists in health sciences of the country. Efforts are on to establish contact with various institutions towards achieving this goal.

UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS:

New buildings of the University and its constituent college, GGS Medical College & Hospital were completed in the year 2011. The university was shifted to its new building situated at Sadiq Road, Faridkot in July 2011. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab inaugurated two new University buildings (Senate Block and Academic Block) on 22-09-2011. Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister inaugurated the Radiotherapy Unit, and other buildings of GGS Medical College & Hospital, on 23-09-2011. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University is also shifted to its new building.

The University Campus comprises of GGS Medical College along with Auditorium of 800 capacity, Senate Block, Academic Block, University College of Nursing, University College of Physiotherapy, University Institute of Para-Medical Sciences, University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Dept. of Nuclear Medicine, Telemedicine, Edusat and a well equipped state-of-the-art 1200 bedded hospital, Drug De-addiction & Treatment Centre at Faridkot. The State Institute of Nursing and Para-Medical Sciences, Village – Badal (Muktsar), Institute of Nursing (University Regional Centre) at Shri Goindwal Sahib and Advanced Cancer Diagnostic Treatment & Research Centre and Drug De-Addiction & Treatment Centre at Bathinda are also run by University.

Coveted projects to set up Trauma Centre, Regional Cancer Centre are in process. The University has added to its academic convoy University Library & Informatics Division, Department of Health Sciences Library & Information System, University Centre of Excellence in Research, Rose Garden and Herbal Garden.

The university has started number of employment-oriented diploma courses and certificate programs in health sciences and allied services.

COLLEGES AFFILIATED WITH UNIVERSITY:

At present the University is having 165 affiliated colleges (09 Medical,14 Dental, 124 Nursing, 08 Physiotherapy, 1 Pharmacy, 1 Sports Medicine and 7 allied and health care) comprising 153 affiliated and 11 constituent Colleges.

University will soon endeavor to achieve excellence in health care delivery and medical education and research in the State. Admissions to various undergraduate and post graduate courses in the affiliated institutions of this University in the State of Punjab are made on merit basis through the conduct of Entrance Tests. The PPMET-2025 is being accordingly conducted to enroll suitable candidates in the Nursing Colleges of the State for the session 2025.

The university is now primarily focusing on strengthening postgraduate medical education and research and evolving as a centre of excellence in a rural backdrop.

Selection of the candidates to any institution shall be made on merit and in transparent manner as per Punjab Government Notification/s.

DEFINITIONS:

- (i) "B.Sc. (Nursing) Post Basic " means Bachelor of Science (Nursing) Post Basic.
- (ii) "BFUHS" means Baba Farid University of Health Science, Faridkot.
 - "Council" means the national statutory council regulating a particular discipline
- (iii) "Eligible Candidate" means a candidate who satisfies the requirements of eligibility as per provisions of this prospectus, University regulations and as per Regulations/Directions of Indian Nursing Council and the criteria of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- (iv) "University" means Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Sadiq Road, Faridkot.

Important Instructions – Read carefully

Candidates are required to go through the Prospectus carefully and acquaint themselves:-

- 1. Candidates <u>except NRI</u> can apply for B.Sc Para Medical Courses- 2025 through **"Online" mode** only.
- 2. Prospectus can be downloaded from the University website www.bfuhs.ac.in
- 3. Candidates must retain this Prospectus with them till admission process is over. Read and comply with all instructions therein strictly.
- 4. Online submission of Application Form can only be made by accessing University website <u>www.bfuhs.ac.in</u>
- 5. Instructions for Online submission of Application Form are available in the Prospectus and on the University website i.e. <u>www.bfuhs.ac.in</u>
- 6. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Prospectus and University website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- 7. Candidates must retain the following documents with them as reference for future correspondence.
 - a. At least three printouts of online submitted application form.
 - b. Proof of payment of fee.
 - c. 3 copies of latest identical coloured Photograph with date (should be passport size with white background) that scanned and uploaded on the Online Application form.

Note: Photograph should not have cap or goggles. Spectacles are allowed if being used regularly. POLAROID and COMPUTER generated photos are not acceptable. Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected. Candidates may please note that if it is found that photograph affixed is fabricated i.e. deshaped or seems to be hand-made or computer made, the form of the candidate will be rejected and the same would be considered as using unfair means practices and candidate would accordingly be dealt with the rules of unfair means.

- 8. Candidate must ensure that mobile numbers, E-mail address filled in the online Application form are his/her own as University will make communications by SMS or mail on given mobile number and mailing ID only.
- 9. The Candidate himself/herself shall be held responsible for non-receipt of latest information due to wrong mobile number or mailing address filled in the online Application Form.
- 10. Please visit university website <u>www.bfuhs.ac.in</u> for all regular and updated information concerning admissions/Date of counseling of B.Sc Para Medical Courses 2025 from time to time.

- 11. Application fee can only be remitted through University Online payment Gateway. Candidature will be cancelled, who fails to deposit requisite fee within stipulated date and time.
- 12. Application fee once deposited in the University account shall not be Refunded/Adjusted in any case. Therefore, the candidates are advised to deposit the application fee only after determining their eligibility for admission as published in the Prospectus.
- 13. An error in filling ONLINE APPLICATION FORM may result in rejection of such an Application Form. Corrections in the information given by the candidate in the ONLINE APPLICATION FORM may not be permitted.
- 14. Fill category carefully in the online Admission Application Form. Category once claimed will not be changed in any case after submitting the form.

Those candidates, who do not fill/claim any category code as per prospectus or fill a wrong category code other than mentioned in prospectus, will be treated in Open merit. The candidate may select a category code from the codes (see at page no. 14-15) and fill the category accordingly. More than one category may be filled by a candidate if it is considered applicable in the candidate's particular case. Category codes are exclusively for the purpose of facilitating the candidates to know and understand his/her respective merit placement at the time of counseling in various reserved categories as have been filled by him/her. Reserve category selection on the part of the candidate shall not in any case be construed to give him/her any legitimacy or right or claim on the benefits for reserved seats during admission. Claims to admissions against reserved seats in B.Sc. (Para Medical) courses will be on the basis of appropriate claims made in the Admission Application Form subject to rules and regulations contained in the Punjab Government Notifications printed in the Part-B of this prospectus and as per the decisions of the Selection Committee constituted for this purpose by the Punjab Government. No benefit of reservation whatsoever shall be given if the claim is not made in Admission Application Form. Change in category or any other particular is allowed before the last date for submission of application form and thereafter no change will be allowed under any circumstances.

- 15. Candidates will be responsible for any mistakes made by him/her in his/her application form. University shall not be responsible for the same.
- 16. This Prospectus is subject to alteration(s) or modification(s) at any time without notice. For updates please refer to University website from time to time.
- 17. The list of Colleges and availability of seats shown in this prospectus may vary and **the final status shall be displayed at the time of counseling.**
- 18. Reservations of seats in the affiliated institutions in Punjab shall be as per the policy of the Government of Punjab.
- 19. The schedule of Admission/Counseling shall be notified through the Press or University, website. In case of changes (if any), no separate intimation letters will be sent.
- 20. Personal appearance of candidate(s) is essential at the time of Counseling. He/she will produce all documents/ testimonials in original for verification by the **Admission Committee** failing which he/she will not be considered for counseling.

- 21. Eligibility:- The candidate should have passed 10+1 and 10+2 from recognize school/institution situated in the state of Punjab or candidate should be bonafide resident of Punjab. The resident status of Punjab state shall be taken in terms of Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative reforms (PP_II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3 PP II/9619 dated 6th June, 1996, ID No. 1/2/96-3PP-2/8976 dated 7th July, 1998 and ID No. 1/3/95-3PP/II/81 dated 1st January 1999 and any further instructions issued by the Department of Personnel, if any, and the same shall be adhered to in letter and spirits. After exhausting Punjab state candidates, other state candidates will be considered for vacant seats in 2nd/subsequent couselling.
- 22. The eligibility for admission of the candidates shall be determined by the Admission Committee at the time of counseling.
- 23. The candidate should read the eligibility conditions carefully. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in the Prospectus. Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned College. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the allocated candidate before joining/admission. As per Eligibility criteria, those aspirants who will found ineligible will not be considered for admission.
- 24. The candidate may opt for admission to his/her desirable course and institution at the time of counseling. The candidate may opt to change choice of college and course during subsequent round of counseling(s).
- 25. All necessary information regarding allocation of merit and seeking admission to B.Sc. Para Medical Courses in Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot, Advanced Cancer Diagnostic Treatment & Research Centre, Bathinda & Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital, Sangrur, all applicable rules and regulations, etc., are contained in this **PROSPECTUS** for admission to B.Sc. Para Medical Courses. This Prospectus is subject to alteration(s) or modification(s) at any time without notice. For updates please refer to University website from time to time.
- 26. COBSE (Council of Board of School Education in India) grant membership to boards/institutions that are set up by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature or by Executive orders of the Central / State Government and broadly follow the National Curriculum Framework/CBSE. Therefore, candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from member-boards of COBSE are acceptable for admissions. A complete list of members-boards of COBSE can be downloaded from www.cobse.in Boards not in the list of members-boards of COBSE shall not be acceptable for admissions. The Board of Management in its meeting held on 21.08.2013 vide para no. 28, resolved that the list of Boards recognized by COBSE shall be considered for admission to higher courses run by the University.
- 27. University has started Health Sciences Library Network (HSLIBNET) to provide access to e-resources to the students of all colleges affiliated with the University for which onetime fee as mentioned below or as amended from time to time will be charged from all students who got admission in B.Sc. Courses. HSLIBNET fee will be collected alongwith tuition fee at the time of admission: -

- 28. The Post Matric Scholarship Scheme: SC category candidates are entitled for scholarship from the Department of Welfare, Govt. of Punjab if they fulfill their terms and conditions. SC category candidates, whose family annual income from all sources is less than Rs.2,50,000/-(Rupees Two Lakh fifty thousand only) during the last Financial Year, are entitled for post matric scholarship as per guidelines of Govt. of India and Punjab Govt. The candidates will have to submit Freeship Card alongwith admission application from. For details regarding this scheme/forms/procedure, respective colleges/candidates should visit the website of Punjab Govt., Deptt. of Medical Education and Research (www.punjabmedicaleducation.org) and University website (www.bfuhs.ac.in). For any query/clarification, candidates/respective colleges can contact the office of Director, Medical Education and Research, Punjab, Chandigarh. For further information and applying for scholarship candidates may visit http://www.punjabscholarships.gov.in. It is also responsibility of the concerned candidate to ensure that has filled his/her application for scholarship is filled in time.
- The Post Matric Scholarship will be as per guidelines of Govt. of Punjab and amended from time to time.
- 29. This is for the information of all candidates that as per Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COUNSELLING (Online)

- 1. Online counselling will be held through University Website and online counselling form will be made available on University Website as per dates specified in Important Dates.
- 2. The Principals must ensure the following:
 - a) Their Internet connection at college is intact and working
 - b) Joining of the candidate will be online mode only i.e. through College Login ID.
 - c) Excuse of Poor connectivity will not be entertained.
 - d) Committee comprising of Senior Faculty be constituted for scrutiny of documents/checking of eligibility of candidates.
 - e) Deposition of tuition fee be made through online payment gateway system only.
- 3. The candidates should read the eligibility conditions carefully and just exercising online option of college does not entitle him/her for admission. Eligibility conditions for admissions shall be notified as mentioned in the Prospectus under Clause "Eligibility". The eligibility shall be determined by the Selection Committee constituted by the Principal at college level. Those who are not eligible will not be considered for admission and their seat will be treated as cancelled.
- 4. The choice(s) of courses/institutions shall be exercised by the candidate through online portal only at the time of Counseling.
- 5. The allotment of seat and college shall be made choices/preferences on the basis of the merit determined as per marks obtained by the candidate in 10+2 examination and other terms and conditions contained in the Prospectus.
- 6. The candidates shall have to produce all the certificates/degrees/diplomas/ documents in original at the counseling venue/joining/admission in respective colleges.
- 7. Checking/Verification of Original Certificate/Documents: Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Colleges. After provisional allocation of seat, candidate shall have to report to the allocated college for verification of documents and checking of eligibility. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of provisionally allocated candidate before their joining/admission.
- 8. **Deposition of Annual Fee:** After provisional allocation during online counseling, the candidate will deposit tuition fee through online payment gateway only. Candidate will report for medical checkup and joining in the respective allotted college alongwith receipt of fee paid and original documents for verification within stipulated time/period, failing which allocated seat will stand cancelled automatically without any intimation to the candidate.

PROCEDURE OF ONLINE COUNSELLING AND JOINING AT THE COLLEGES

Counselling for admission to B.Sc Para Medical Courses, session 2025 will be conducted followed by Physical reporting of the candidates at allotted colleges. During counseling, candidates will have to submit their preferences of course, college, quota & category through online portal. The Provisional Seat will be allocated as per the merit of qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 and in order of preferences given by the candidate. Therefore, candidates are advised to take care during opting the seat/course. Candidates of reserved categories (who scored marks equivalent or more than the minimum cut-off of open merit) will also be considered in open merit, if open merit seat is available then seat of open merit will be allocated first, otherwise seat of reserved category will be allocated.

After provisional allocation of seat, candidates will have to report to the respective college along with fee receipt and all original documents for checking of documents and eligibility. Merely, issuing of Provisional Selection Slip does not confer any right to claim the allocation of seat in respective college as their selection is provisional subject to verification of documents and checking of eligibility as per guidelines/terms and conditions enshrined in the Prospectus.

If candidate do not follow the said process, his/her allocated seat will be cancelled automatically without any intimation and his/her seat shall be declared as vacant for the subsequent round of counseling.

If candidate is satisfied with seat allocated to him/her, he/she is not required to participate in the subsequent round of counseling(s). In case, candidate wishes/intends to upgrade/change his/her seat he/she will have to participate in the subsequent round of counselling and give his/her preferences afresh for the course/college/quota/ category.

In case any candidate wants to quit the course/seat, he/she will have to submit application to the respective college only regarding his/her surrender of seat well in advance before start of next round of counselling.

In case candidate seat is upgraded/changed in the subsequent round of counselling and he/she has already deposited the tuition fee, he/she is not required to deposit fee again, provided he/she has to deposit any difference in fee, if any.

The seats in 2nd round will be allocated as per availability of seats as per merit cum choice/preference submitted by the candidates.

It is pertinent to mention here that the candidates can fill the choices of colleges/quota which are not reflecting in the vacancy position of seats. In this regard, it is made clear that during 2nd online counseling one can upgrade/shift seat as per his/her choice by vacating the already occupied seat of 1st counseling. This is also made clear that some seats of reserve category, NRI Quota seats etc. may remain vacant after exhausting all candidates of respective quota. Moreover, any seat may become vacant in 2nd round due to shifting/conversion of seats. Hence, it is not mandatory to fill only those choices/preference which are reflected in the vacancy position of seats. So candidates are advised to fill the preference/choices of colleges as per their choice. The seats in 2nd round will be allocated as per availability of seats as per merit cum choice/preference submitted by the candidate.

- 1. All admissions are provisional and are subject to approval by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot
- 2. The courses of study and examinations will be governed by the regulations of BFUHS.
- 3. The Rules and Regulations, including fees, may be revised as and when required and the revised rules and regulations/fee will be applicable irrespective of the conditions mentioned in this prospectus. All Students shall comply with rules & regulations.
- 4. In case of any dispute arising out of any Clause/Provisions of the prospectus, the Civil Court at Faridkot shall have the jurisdiction to entertain and decide the dispute.
- 5. This is for the information of all candidates that as per Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.
- 6. Students, whose conduct and academic standards are considered unsatisfactory, shall not be allowed to appear in the University Examination or to hold any post in any extracurricular committee of the college/department.
- 7. All students must abide by the rules and regulations of the hostel. On failure to do so, disciplinary action will be taken by the hostel/college authorities.

ELIGIBILITY, PROCEDURE AND OTHER CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO B.Sc. (PARA MEDICAL) COURSES

1. Admission criteria and Qualification:

Candidate must have passed 10+2 with the subject of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained <u>40% marks</u> taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

Or

Candidate has passed 10+2 examination in any stream other than science and holding 2 Years full time regular diploma in a paramedical subject from a recognized medical college only.

Lateral Entry: Candidate is eligible for lateral entry directly into the second year of B.Sc. course, if he/she has passed 10+2 (Science) and holding 2 Years full time regular diploma in paramedical subject from a recognized medical college only.

As per letter no F.No 2-6/ASLP/2003/RCI dated 07.05.2024 of Rehabilitation Council of India, Eligibility for Bachelor of Audiology & Speech- Language Pathology is as under:

"The applicant/candidate should have studied Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics/Computer Sciences/Statistics/Electronics/Psychology at 10+2 level" Candidates must have passed 10+2 or an equivalent examination from a recognized Board with minimum of 50% aggregate marks. Relaxation in the qualifying marks shall be as per rules and regulations of respective University/State/UTs or Central Government.

2. Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made as per the merit of **Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) marks** taken together in 10+2 examination

In case of two or more candidates having equal marks in PCB in 10+2 examination, their inter-se merit will be determined as Under:-

- i) Candidate having higher marks in Biology
- ii) Candidate older in age.

3. Medium of Instructions:

The medium of instruction of the course and examination shall be English.

4. <u>Course Fee to be paid by the students (Per annum) For Guru Gobind Singh Medical College &</u> <u>Hospital, Faridkot & Advance Cancer Institute, Bathinda</u>

Rs. 30,000/- p.a. (Hostel/Mess fee will be extra). The hostel facility is subject to availability and permission of Principal of concerned college.

Fee revised by of the Board of Management (BOM) in the meeting held on 01-03-2015. The course fee shall be charged by the concerned college and is inclusive of Annual University Fee of Rs. 3,500/- per admitted student per course to be paid to the University by the college.

- 5. <u>Course Fee to be paid by the students (Per annum) For Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital, Sangrur</u> Rs. 30,000/- p.a. (Hostel/Mess fee will be extra). The hostel facility is subject to availability and permission of Principal of concerned college.
- 6. If candidate leaves the course within two years he will have to submit full course fee.
- 7. Non-Resident Indian (NRI) SEATS:

1. 15% seats in all private institutes and 7.5% seats in Government/University Institutes shall be earmarked for the Foreign Indian students (NRI).

2. The Foreign Indian Student (NRI) quota in private Institutes will be part of the management quota.

3. The candidates for Foreign Indian Students (NRI) seats in these institutions will be admitted on merit determined on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination equivalent to 10+2 examination of P.S.E.B./C.B.S.E./I.C.S.E. in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and English (PCBE) taken together. The equivalence, merit and eligibility of the candidates will be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, who will issue an eligibility certificate to such candidates. They are not required to take the entrance test. However, they should have passed in such qualifying examinations in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually as regular candidate from the recognized Institute/University and should have obtained at least 50% marks. For admission to State/University institutes of Nursing, against Foreign Indian Students (NRI) seats the candidate shall apply to concerned colleges on the prescribed form for Foreign Indian Students (NRI) seats as per provision the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of admission, Fixation of fee and making of Reservation) Act 2006 as amended from time to time.

4. NRI seats will be filled in the following order :

Category I: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to the state of Punjab.

Category II: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to an Indian State other than Punjab.

I) Under this policy Non Resident Indian means a person of Indian Origin, whether holding an Indian Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:

i) for or on taking up employment outside India; or

ii) for carrying on a business or vocation outside India, or

iii) for any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India shall be taken into consideration

5. The eligibility of the candidates shall be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot who shall issue an eligibility certificate to each such candidate.

6. The NRI students shall have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in instalments as provided.

7. The Centralized Counselling of NRI quota seats shall be held before the Counselling for other categories. In case of any seat remaining vacant under NRI quota, it shall go to General Category and in the Private Colleges shall go to General Category of the Management quota. The NRI left over seats shall be filled by the same Admission Committee.

Note- (a) If sufficient number of candidates under first Category are eligible and available

then they will admitted first even if students under subsequent category are higher in merit.(b) The Foreign Indian Students (NRI) will have to submit a bank guarantee/surety bond

for the Balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments."

I am directed to invite your attention to the Punjab Government Circular Letter No.1/3/95-3PP II/2043, dated 29/1/1996 vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for purposes of admission to educational institutions (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgement delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain Vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-4121 wherein it was held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Residence' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government on the subject. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government to revise the Government instructions referred to above as under:

With reference to letter No.1/3/95-3PII/9619, dated the 6th June, 1996 of this Department on the subject noted above and to say that keeping in view the hardship being faced by the Employees in getting the 'Residence Certificate' it has been decided to decentralize the powers of issuing the 'Residence Certificate' in process of the categories mentioned below:-

Categories:

ii) Children/wards of

- a) The employees of Punjab Government posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having at least 3 years of service.
- b) the employees of Government of India posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Government for a period of 3 years.
- c) the employees of State Government institutions/undertaking who are posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Government for a period of 3 years.
- the employees having at least 3 years of service in autonomous bodies/ companies in which Punjab Government has 20% or more shares.

The Heads of the office shall be competent to issue the requisite certificate to the employees with the exception that in the case of head of Office, the Head of the Department shall be the Competent Authority to issue the certificate

From: Chief Secretary to Government of Punjab to all the Heads of the department etc.

Subject: Issuance of certificate for the purpose of seeking admission to various educational/technical/professional institutions in the state and also for employment.

Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of Government that educational authorities and institutions prescribe various certificates regarding residence, SC/BC category and backward area etc. to be furnished by the students/candidates with the applications forms for entrance examinations or employment in the formats and by the authorities different from those prescribed by the Government departments. Cases have also been reported where the authorities concerned insist on retaining original certificates and refuse to accept the attested photo copies of the certificates. All this results in harassment and panic among the students/candidates and their parents/guardian, since they have to apply with such certificates to more than one authorities simultaneously and within a limited period. The lists of certificates required at the time of applying for CET/PPBNET/PMT and PAU are enclosed by way of illustration.

- 2. In order to overcome the difficulty mentioned above, it has been decided by the Government that following procedure has been decided by the Government that the following procedure shall be followed meticulously by all the educational and other authorities concerned:
 - i) Certificates issued in the format and by the authorities prescribed by the Government Departments shall be accepted as valid by all educational institutions and other authorities.
 - ii) Where a number of authorities have been authorized to issue the certificates there shall be no insistence on issue of a certificate by any particular authority or by the highest authority indicated in the format.
 - iii) (a) In case of entrance examinations, no certificate should be called for in the first instance alongwith the application form. It will be sufficient for the candidate seeking admission or other facility to indicate in the application from whether he/she belongs to any particular category entitling him/her to certain concessions or facility. Requisite certificates may be obtained only from the selected/wait listed candidates.
 - iii) (b) To further simplify the procedure attested copies of the certificates only shall be retained and original certificates if required to be produced at the time of interview shall be returned immediately, thereafter.
 - iv) Parents/guardian or candidates can also obtain SC certificates from the Head of the institution where the candidates has studied if the proof is available in the school records.
 - v) The persons who are employed in Government of India or any other State Government are to be treated at par with the employees of the Government of Punjab in the matter of issue of Scheduled Caste certificate provided relevant Scheduled Caste certificate exists in their service record. The Scheduled Caste certificate in such will be issued by the respective Heads of Departments in the Proforma below:-
